Ian Pearson, Futurologist for BT. He graduated in Applied Mathematics and Theoretical Physics from Queens University, Belfast. After four years in missile design, he joined BT laboratories, analysing the computer networks and protocols. He has since worked in optical networks, broadband network evolution, cybernetics, mobile systems and emerging technologies, and has regularly advised on strategic implications of these technologies along the way.

He now concentrates on mapping the progress of new developments throughout information technology, considering both technological and social implications. He currently works as BT's futurologist and as a consultant. His current research is on conscious computing, bionics, and ultra-simple IT systems. He has received nine awards for his published papers, and has made over 170 TV and radio appearances. He has been BT's Futurologist for 13 years, keeping track of developments across the whole field of technology and informing BT on emerging opportunities and threats.

Sought after internationally as a conference speaker, he delivers provocative views on the impact of future technology on business and society, and attracts much media attention. Most of his audiences comprise senior managers and his customers include many Blue Chip companies and central governments. He is an excellent speaker, lively and witty with content to match any level of audience.
